
Greetings, Companions -

Greetings, Companions - The Grand Pathways festival has been canceled for 2024 with the alternative being the Great Plains Rendezvous in Sterling, Colorado on June 22nd. This will be hosted by the Grand Council of Colorado. For those who have never attended, it is composed of Kansas, Wyoming and Colorado Grand Councils and rotates through the three states. Kansas will be putting on the Royal Master degree, Wyoming the Select Master degree and Colorado the Super Excellent Master degree. I encourage all Companions to attend. At both of these visitations, the MIGM presented the Cryptic Masonry Education Course and it is hoped that it will be used for Masonic Education over several meetings.


Excerpts from the Cryptic Mason Education Course, pages 7 - 8:

"... the Cryptic Degrees of the York Rite are 'one of the smallest but one of the most important and certainly one of the most curious of all the rites.' Both the Royal Master and the Select Master Degrees are of the type known as French *Ecossais* Degrees. There are numerous degrees under the same, or a similar name, but they all have one particular in common— they detail the method adopted for the preservation of the true Word.

"In the higher grades of Masonry, these (degrees) are often labeled the Ninth Arch, Secret Vault, or Sacred Vault Degrees, and carry the name 'Cryptic,' as derived from the Greek *crupe* or the Latin *crypta*, meaning to 'hide' or 'conceal' or 'secret.' Thus, the central theme of these degrees all resolve around a vault, cave, or place of underground concealment."

This is a fascinating course. It also describes why the Cryptic degrees are presented out of chronological order with the other York Rite degrees. I hope this little snippet

Right Illustrious Grand Deputy Master' Message

King Solomon is said to have placed the Ark of the Covenant in the Sanctum Sanctorum, or Holy of Holies, in the temple in Jerusalem. Biblical references tell us the Ark was built by Moses at the command of God in order to hold the Ten Commandments. The Israelites carried it for 40 years as they wandered in the desert, where it was eventually brought to Shiloh, then to Jerusalem by Solomon's father, King David.

Masonic legend tells us that King Solomon built a replica of the ark, and it is this replica that is featured in the Royal Arch degrees, and in the Cryptic Council Select Master degree. One of the items placed in this replica Ark was Aaron's rod. Referring back to the Bible, in Numbers 17:10, we read

"And the Lord said unto Moses, bring Aaron's rod again before the testimony, to be kept for a token."

Aaron was the older Brother of Moses, and was appointed by God to be a prophet for Moses. Aaron carried a rod that Moses commanded him to cast on the ground. When it was cast on the ground, it turned into a serpent. The Pharoah's sorcerers did the same with their rods, but Aaron's serpent swallowed theirs. Later, in order to stop the complaints of the Israelites, God commands that each of the Twelve Tribes provide a rod. Only that of the tribe chosen to become priests would miraculously sprout overnight. Aaron provides his rod to represent the tribe of Levi, and it budded and blossomed as evidence of the exclusive right to the priesthood of the tribe of Levi. This is why it was commanded the rod be stored "before the testimony".

The rod was said to have borne two types of fruit. On one end, sweet almonds to provide nourishment for God's people, and on the other bitter almonds if the Hebrews should ever stray from God's path. Bitter almonds contain amygdalin, which the body will metabolize into hydrogen cyanide – a deadly poison.

Our lesson of Aaron's rod in the Select Master degree is that as long as we are faithful and walk in the path of God, our lives too will bear the nourishment of sweet almonds. Should we stray, we will then suffer from the bitterness of almonds.

- I. Entered Apprentice A few years before the death of Hiram Abiff
- II. Fellowcraft A couple of years before the death of Hiram
- III. Royal Master (First Section) Just prior to the death of Hiram
- IV. Select Master Just prior to the death of Hiram
- V. Master Mason At the death of Hiram
- VI. Royal Master (Second Section) Just after the death of Hiram
- VII. Mark Master Just before the completion of the Temple
- VIII. Most Excellent Master Shortly after the death of Hiram
- IX. Past Master Sometime after the death of Hiram
- X. **Super Excellent Master –** Beginning at the destruction of King Solomon's Temple
- XI. **Red Cross –** During the time of Prince Zerubbabel and the building of the second Temple
- XII. Royal Arch At the building of the second Temple
- XIII. Order of Malta Approximately 1,000 years after the birth of Christ
- XIV. Order of the Temple Approximately 1118 A.D.
